MR. KENYON COX

Was born at Warren, Ohio, 1856. Studied with Carolus-Duran and Gerome, Paris, and is now a resident of New York, where he has won many honors in his profession. Among them, may be enumerated the Second Hallgarten Prize at the National Academy of Design, 1889; Two Bronze Medals, Paris Exposition, 1889; Temple Silver Medal, Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts, 1891; Medal, Columbian Exposition, Chicago, 1893; Gold Medal, Louisiana Purchase Exposition, St. Louis, 1904.

He was made a member of the National Academy 1903; Society of American Artists, 1882; Mural Painters; New York Architectural League, 1889; Art Students' League; National Institute of Arts and Letters, and a Fellow of the Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts.

He is a writer on art and a teacher in the Art Students' League, as well as one of America's best mural painters.
