EVERETT L. WARNER was born in Vinton, Iowa, on July
16, 1877. He studied at the Art Students' League in
Washington and New York and the Julian Academy in
Paris.

He was elected an associate member of the National Academy in 1912. He is an associate member of the Paris-American Art Association, the New York Water Color Club, the American Water Color Society, and the Society of

Washington Artists.

He received the First Corcoran Prize at the Washington Water Color Club, 1902; the Sesman Gold Medal at the Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts, 1908; Silver Medal at the International Exposition of Fine Arts at Buenos Aires, 1910; the Second Hallgarten Prize at the National Academy of Design, 1912; the William T. Evans Prize at the Salmagundi Club, 1913; Bronze Medal at the Society of Washington Artists, 1913; and the Vezin Prize at the Salmagundi Club, 1914.

He is represented in the Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts, the Corcoran Gallery of Art in Washington, the Toledo Art Museum, the Syracuse Museum of Fine Arts, the Rhode Island School of Design, the National Arts Club of New York, the Louisville Public Library, the Public Library of Erie, Pa.; the Boston Museum of Fine Arts, the City Art Museum, St. Louis, and the New York Public Library.
