## Introduction

THE present collection of French and Belgian art which constitutes the initial exhibition for this season at the Detroit Museum of Art is made up of the greater part of the French and Belgian collections shown at the Panama-Pacific International Exposition.

Like the collections of Spanish art, Swedish art, and other foreign exhibitions shown during the past three years under the auspices of the Museum, the French collection will give a splendid insight into a vital national art; one which has nurtured many of our American painters, and which has been the source and inspiration of their spirited craftsmanship. The Belgian collection, though somewhat meager, is sturdy in quality and reflects the national characteristics of the Belgian people.

The exhibition is not designed to be retrospective, but represents the general trend of French art of the present day. It is the kind of exhibition one would find in the salon des Beaux Arts, Société Nouvelle or other current shows of Paris. The works are chiefly those produced during the past fifteen years by eminent craftsmen, regardless of the trend of their ideas.

Unlike other European countries that have been content to live in the halo of reflected glory of past accomplishment, France has set the pace in art for the modern world for decade after decade. Her art has been vital for three centuries. It is eternally in search of something new. In the swinging of the pendulum from one extreme to the other, excellent craftsmanship has dominated each new movement. The staleness of perfection is ever being supplanted by the leaven of the new. Claude and David were superseded by Gericault Delacroix, the Barbizon men and other

romanticists, who were in turn supplanted by Courbet, the Impressionists, and all that realism implies. Each great figure in the history of French art has been baptized into his sphere, an innovator, only to be regarded as academic and a reactionary by his followers.

Undying loyalty to an idea backed by alluring devices of craftsmanship has kept French art ever in the forefront, and an eternal well-spring from which the world might draw. Constant revolution has been the incentive of the marked progress painting has made in the past century.

The present collection is remarkable for its brilliancy. In its wide variety may be discerned on the part of the more radical a striving for the undiscovered. There will be found also more conservative men, whose art is based on a firm adherence to the traditions of the past. In all works one finds the excellent craftsmanship which characterizes all French art.

The Detroit Museum of Art acknowledges its indebtedness to those in charge of the French section of the Fine Arts Department of the Panama-Pacific International Exposition for allowing this exhibition to be shown in the more important art centers of America, and to the Buffalo Fine Arts Academy and the Albright Art Gallery under whose auspices the collection is on circuit.
