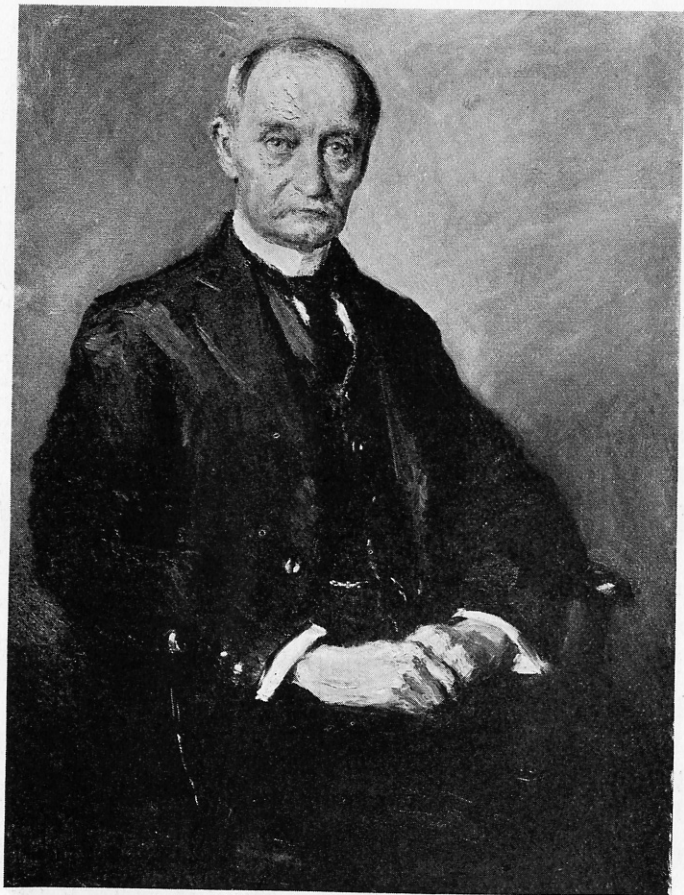
## Introduction

**T**HE Third Annual Exhibition of Selected Paintings by American Artists presented herewith may be regarded as thoroughly representative of the work of contemporary American painters. The pictures were invited from the important 1917 exhibitions at the Corcoran Gallery of Art, Washington, D. C., The Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts, Philadelphia, and the National Academy of Design, New York, supplemented by loans from private collections and from the studios of artists. It is a satisfaction to number among them so many paintings honored with important awards by competent artist juries.

In this exhibition it has been the aim to select without partiality or prejudice, works covering a wide range of subject and treatment. It is important that the newer forces and tendencies, particularly those which concern themselves devotedly and sincerely with the expression of problems and motives of the present day, should be shown if one is to get a comprehensive idea of the accomplishment of our American painters.

The Trustees gratefully acknowledge their indebtedness to the artist and owners who have contributed works for this exhibition and to those who have otherwise given of their advice and co-operation in making it a success.

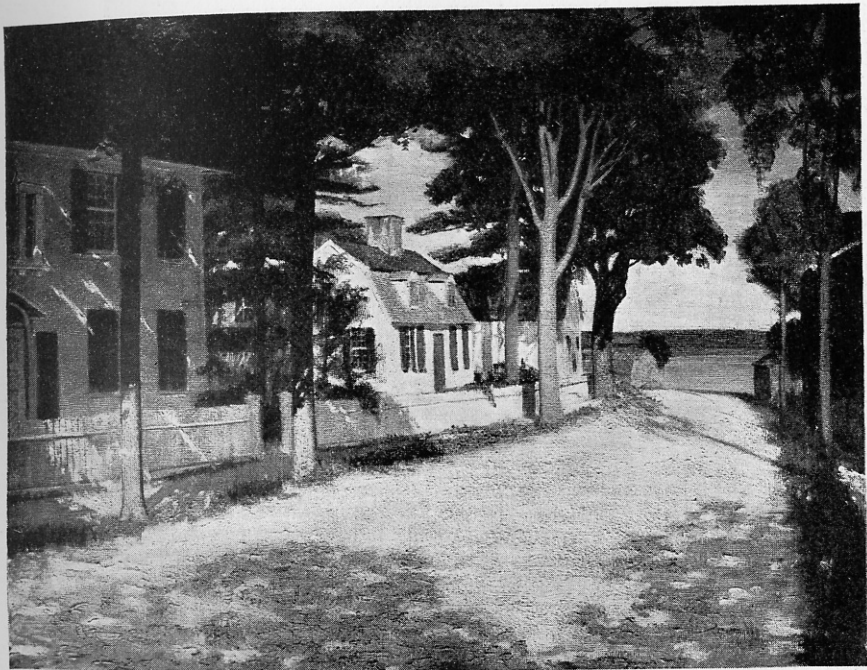

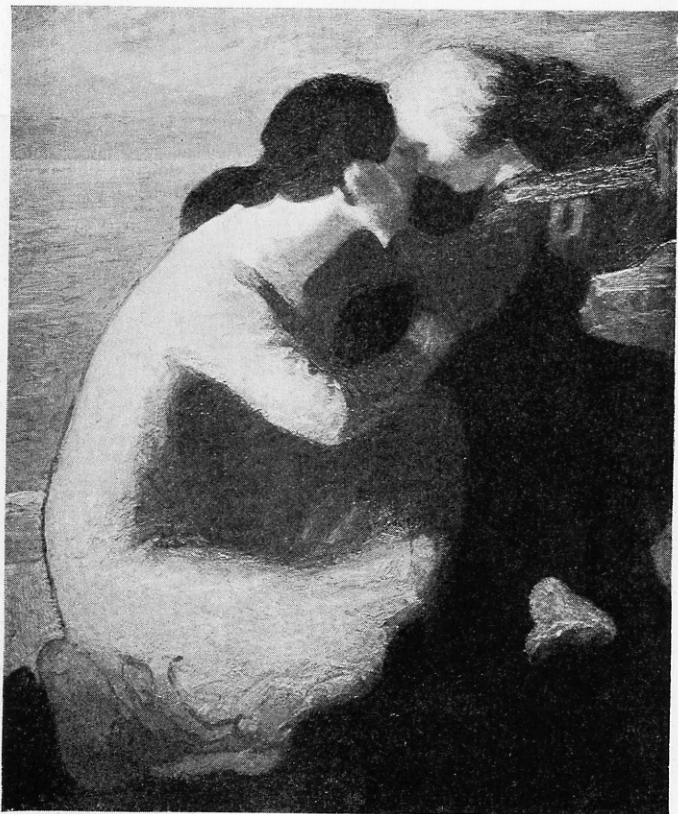

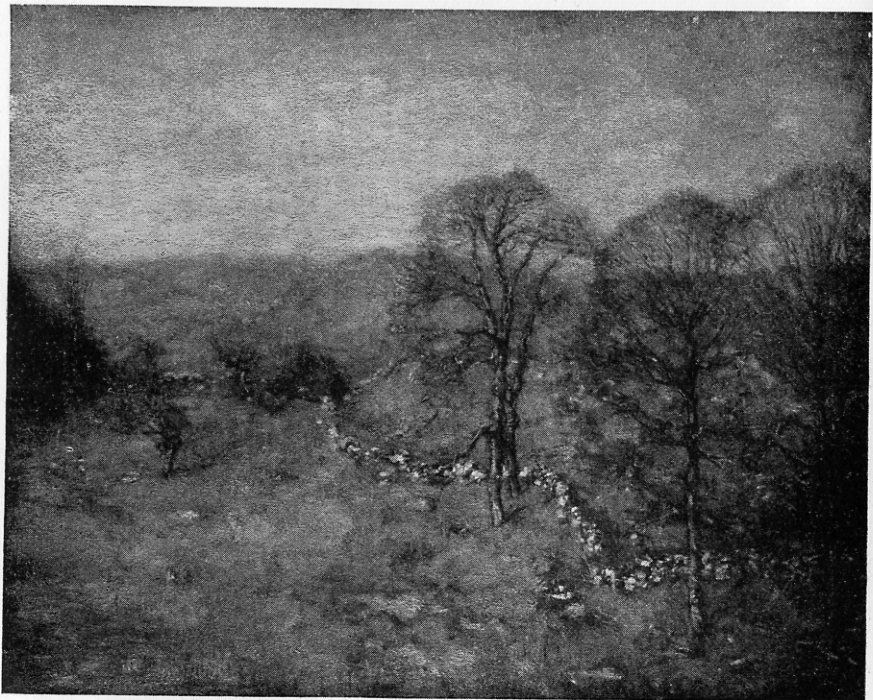

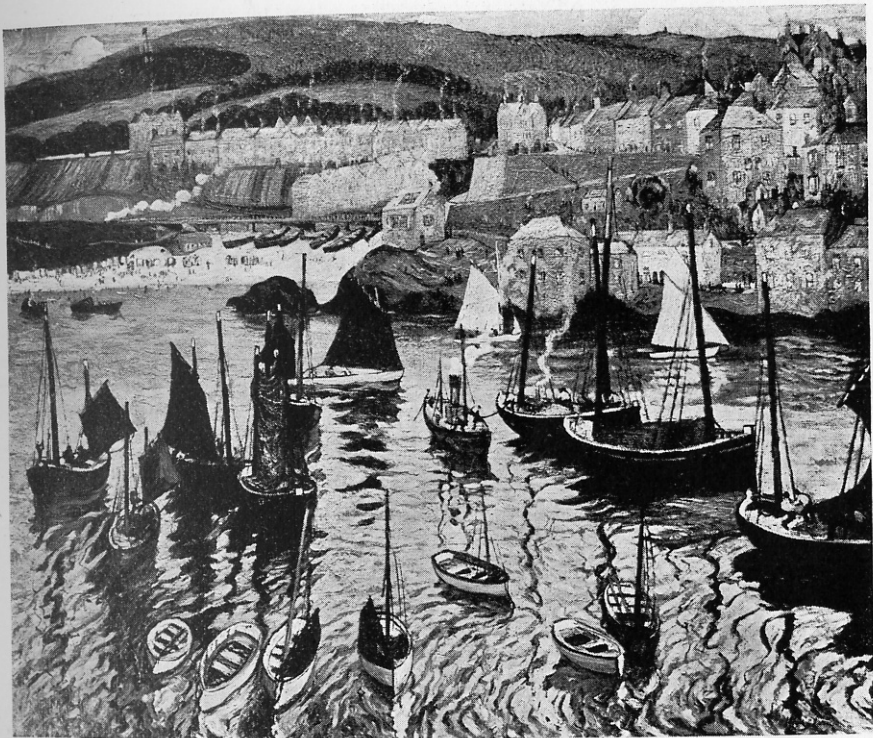
